







What does Hospital-based HTA mean?





- Tailoring HTA to specific hospital circumstances (comparators, how care is organized in the hospital, BIA,...)
- Keeping a sharper focus on the HTs that are of specific interest for the hospital
- · Timely adjustment to hospital context

Strategic objectives of the project


- 1. To perform a critical analysis of current formally established HB- HTA functions;




