Diagnostic Services Utilization

- ▶ 70-90 % of all clinical decisions
- ~3500 tests available
- Enormous expenditure
- Annual increases second only to pharmaceuticals
- Wide variations exist
- Quality issue

Laboratory Connection to Diagnostic Error


- Ordering an inappropriate test


